REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

October 20, 2025

- 1) The Randolph School Board met in regular session on Monday, October 20, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Conference Room 1. Gary Moorhouse called the meeting to order. Directors present: Gary Moorhouse, Jason Podritz, Cory Lorenzen, Leah Radman, Regina Wernimont, and Scott Otte. Administrators present: Michael Kelley, Mike Schmidt, Trina Bilderback, Rio Severson. - 2) A motion to approve the agenda as established was made by Jason Podritz, seconded by Scott Otte. All members voting in favor.
- 3) A motion was made by Regina Wernimont, seconded by Leah Radman to approve the following consent agenda items:
